## Design Contest Will Determine the New “I Voted” Sticker for Cape Girardeau County

The Cape Girardeau County Clerk’s Office announces the start of an “I Voted” Sticker Design Contest. The contest is open to all high school students in the County and the winning design will be used as the official “I Voted” sticker distributed at the polls during the 2018-2019 election years. The deadline to submit a design is October 31, 2017.

This is the first time the contest has been held in Cape Girardeau County. The contest allows for high school students to become involved in the election process.

“We are excited to allow local high school students the opportunity to be involved,” said County Clerk Kara Clark Summers. “Our goal is to encourage students to participate civically by using their creative talents.”

After all designs have been submitted, finalists will be selected by a distinguished panel of judges. Judging will be based on the artistic skill, theme, and uniqueness of the design. The Cape Girardeau County Clerk’s Office will then hold an online public vote to allow all residents of the County to have input on their favorite design.

“It will be interesting to see the submitted designs and have an “I Voted” sticker unique to our County,” added Kara Clark Summers.

Contestants must agree to the Official Rules of the contest and submit their designs by completing a Design Entry Form. All submissions must be made electronically by 5:00 PM on October 31, 2017.
